Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to PowerScout to develop the functionalities for PowerScout ConnectTM and PowerScout TargetTM and demonstrate their ability to reduce customer acquisition costs through big-data analytics and easy-to-use, customer-facing software.

The proposed activities would include computer modeling, data science and analysis, website design, and online product development. The proposed project would use no physical materials beyond basic office supplies and hardware. Work for the proposed project would take place at the kWh analytics offices in San Francisco, CA.

Based on review of the project information and the above analysis, DOE has determined the proposed project would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment.
