Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

CX, EA, EIS APPENDIX AND NUMBER:

Description:

The installation, modification, operation, and removal of electric vehicle charging stations, using commercially B5.23 available technology, within a previously disturbed or developed area. Covered actions are limited to areas Electric where access and parking are in accordance with applicable requirements (such as local land use and zoning charging requirements) in the proposed project area and would incorporate appropriate control technologies and best stations management practices.

Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide funding to the Nevada Department of Administration to construct an electric vehicle (EV) charging station. The proposed project is part of the Nevada Electric Highway Project, and the Valley Electric Association as the sub-recipient would be responsible for the installation of the charging station. The charging station would be comprised of one to three pedestal type chargers and would be installed in an existing parking lot. The charger would include one DC Fast Charger, and either one dual-port Level 2 Charger or two single-port Level 2 Chargers. The EV charging station would be approximately 1-4' by 2'-4' wide by 5' -6' tall.

The charging station would be located in the parking lot of Stagecoach Eddie World gas station which is located at 900 E Hwy 95 N, Beatty, NV 89003. Necessary project activities would include, the construction of two to four concrete pads and the placement of EV charging equipment (pedestals), installation of electrical conduit, trenching and repair of existing concrete curbing and asphalt parking surface, electric panel upgrades and additional electrical enhancements to accommodate the fast charger higher voltage requirements, and necessary lighting and parking striping.

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) Endangered Species Program website (iPaC) identifies 4 endangered or threatened species that are known or believed to be present in Nye County, Nevada. Due to the lack of critical habitat in the vicinity of the site and the previously developed/urban setting of the project site, DOE has determined the proposed project will have no effect on threatened and endangered species in the area. Additionally, iPaC identifies 14 Birds of Conservation Concern known or believed to be present in Nye County. Impacts to migratory birds are anticipated to be insignificant due to the previously developed/urban setting of the project site and because this project not represent any change to the existing used of the parking lot and fueling station.

The project would be located outside of the 100-year floodplain. Historical or cultural resources are not known to occur near the project site based on the National Register of Historic Places Database. Therefore, no impacts to these resources are anticipated.

Based on a review of the project information and the above analysis, DOE has determined that the proposed project would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment. DOE has determined that this project is consistent with actions outlined in DOE categorical exclusions B5.23 "Electric vehicle

charging stations" and is therefore categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
