Rationale for determination:

The Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to issue a Funding Opportunity Announcement (DE-FOA-0001513) that would lead to the selection of 20 to 30 U.S. based universities, with partnering organizations, as "Industrial Assessment Centers" (IACs). The Industrial Assessment Centers would provide extensive training for undergraduate and graduate engineering students in industrial processes, energy assessment procedures, and energy management principles.

IAC-related faculty and staff would lead IAC students in the performance of energy assessments for small and medium sized manufacturers in their geographic region, which would result in energy and water savings, waste reduction, potential enhancements to cyber security, opportunities for smart manufacturing, and sustainability and productivity improvements for the manufacturers and real-world experience for the students. All project activities would consist exclusively of intellectual, academic, analytical activities and technical advice/assistance. These activities would include performing energy saving assessments for small and medium sized enterprises, training undergraduate and graduates to perform these assessments as well as providing them the information needed to understand energy efficiency in a manufacturing environment.

Based on review of the FOA, DOE has determined that any project selected under this FOA would consist of activities that would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment. DOE has determined that FOA activities are consistent with actions contained in DOE categorical exclusions A9 "Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination," and A11 "Technical advice and assistance to organizations," and are categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
