Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

Description:

A9 Information and dissemination

Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and gathering, analysis, audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. B5.16 Solar photovoltaic systems

The installation, modification, operation, and removal of commercially available solar photovoltaic systems located on a building or other structure (such as rooftop, parking lot or facility, and mounted to signage, lighting, gates, or fences), or if located on land, generally comprising less than 10 acres within a previously disturbed or developed area. Covered actions would be in accordance with applicable requirements (such as local land use and zoning requirements) in the proposed project area and would incorporate appropriate control technologies and best management practices.

Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to GE Global Research Center to develop and demonstrate power electronics technologies that address micro-inverter system limitations. DOE completed a previous NEPA review (GFO-0005344-001 CX A9 & B3.6 11/9/2011) authorizing power electronics research and development and prototype development. However, this determination excluded the proposed pilot demonstration based on the fact that they had not determined the location for said demonstration. This NEPA determination applies only to the pilot demonstration activities of the proposed project.

GE Global Research Center seeks to design, build, install and operate two pilot, smart grid-ready, photovoltaic systems with micro-inverter module interfaces. Building the prototypes of the micro-inverters and functional testing of the micro-inverters including grid connection communication and smart grid support functions would take place at GE Global's industrial research and development facility located at 1 Research Circle in Niskayuna, NY. Installation and operation of the 2.5kW solar photovoltaic system would take place in two separate locations: Innovative Test Solutions industrial testing facility located at 551 Kings Road in Schenectady, NY and SolarWorld Americas LLC's industrial facility located at 4650 25300 NW Evergreen Road in Hillsboro, OR. All of these locations are pre-existing sites and would require no additional licensing and/or permitting. No physical modifications would be made to any of the existing test setups. Panels in existing setups would be replaced by new panels with integrated micro-inverters.

Waste material generated by the proposed project would be disposed of according to local, state and federal regulations and no hazardous waste would be produced as a result of the proposed project. GE Global Research has OSHA and NFPA (National Fire Protection Associated) 70E certified safety protocols implemented in the lab. Corporate health and safety policies and procedures would be followed, where proper protective equipment would be used by trained personnel to install the solar panels. As per GE policy an internal safety review would be performed before system operation to verify system safety before beginning of demonstration.

Based on review of the project information and the above analysis, DOE has determined the proposed project would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or the environment. DOE has determined the proposed project is consistent with actions outlined in DOE categorical exclusion A9 "Information gathering, analysis and dissemination" and B5.16 "Solar photovoltaic systems" and is therefore categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
