Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to the Midwest Renewable Energy Association (MREA) to strengthen the Midwest Grow Solar Partnership to develop the relevant authority, coordination, and reach to scale the solar PV market across the Midwest.

The proposed project would provide technical assistance to municipal jurisdictions, utilities, developers, and policymakers to streamline approval processes, demonstrate scalable financing arrangements, and clarify the impacts of policies related to the installation of solar photovoltaic arrays on residential, commercial, and utility sites.

Based on review of the project information and the above analysis, DOE has determined that the proposed activities would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or environment. DOE has determined the proposed project is consistent with actions outlined in DOE categorical exclusion A9 "information gathering, analysis and dissemination" and A11 "technical advice and assistance to organizations," and is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
