Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

Description:

A9 Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination

Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. (See also B3.1 of appendix B to this subpart.)

Rationale for determination:

The Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide funding to the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Prisons in support of the proposed Federal Prison Photovoltaic Systems Project. This project was selected by DOE under the Assisting Federal Facilities with Energy Conservation Technologies (AFFECT) Funding Opportunity Announcement (DE-FOA-0000901).

The recipient is proposing to use DOE funds for two tasks in support of the proposed project. Task 1 would include system design for three photovoltaic systems to be installed at three different federal prisons. Subtasks within Task 1 include site visits, 75% through final design drawings, equipment specifications, and applications documents for utility review. Task 2 would involve development of a training curriculum for inmate training to install the photovoltaic systems.

The recipient is a federal agency and is also required to comply with NEPA. When the recipient has completed their NEPA review process for the proposed project, they will provide this information to DOE in an EQ-1. DOE will make a final NEPA Determination prior to authorizing the expenditure of DOE funding for final review, final design, procurement, and implementation of the proposed project.

DOE has determined that Tasks 1.1 through 1.3 and 2 of the proposed project would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or the environment. Further, DOE has determined that Tasks 1.1 - 1.3 and 2 are consistent with CX A9 "Information gathering, analysis and dissemination" and are categorically excluded from further NEPA review.

NEPA PROVISION

DOE has made a conditional NEPA determination for this award, and funding for certain tasks under this award is contingent upon the final NEPA determination.

Insert the following language in the award:

You are restricted from taking any action using federal funds, which would have an adverse affect on the environment or limit the choice of reasonable alternatives prior to DOE/NSA providing either a NEPA clearance or a final NEPA decision regarding the project.

Prohibited actions include:

Subtasks 1.4 and 1.5

This restriction does not preclude you from:

Subtasks 1.1 through 1.3

Task 2

If you move forward with activities that are not authorized for federal funding by the DOE Contracting Officer in advance of the final NEPA decision, you are doing so at risk of not receiving federal funding and such costs may not be recognized as allowable cost share.

Note to Specialist :

This NEPA determination requires a tailored NEPA provision.
