B5.16 Solar The installation, modification, operation, and removal of commercially available solar photovoltaic systems photovoltaic located on a building or other structure (such as rooftop, parking lot or facility, and mounted to signage, lighting, gates, or fences), or if located on land, generally comprising less than 10 acres within a previously

disturbed or developed area. Covered actions would be in accordance with applicable requirements (such as local land use and zoning requirements) in the proposed project area and would incorporate appropriate control technologies and best management practices.

Rationale for determination:

The Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide funding to the State of Colorado Energy Office to design, procure, and install roof top solar photovoltaic (PV) on client homes eligible under the Weatherization Program with Program Year 2016 funds. The PV systems would be installed on only eligible single family homes, as defined by the use of an energy audit which demonstrates that the savings over the life of the measure discounted to present value outweigh the initial cost. No structural improvements of the roof or building would be made to any of the homes, beyond the necessary electrical connections for the project. Each PV system would be net-metered with a grid connection. Installation of these systems would require additional wiring and electric breaker equipment to tie the solar PV system to the existing electric service for the home. All PV systems would be up to a 5kW system or smaller. No ground disturbance would be required.

All permits from the local jurisdictions and agreements with the local electrical utility would be obtained.

Based on review of the project information, DOE has determined that project activities would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or the environment. DOE has determined that these activities are consistent with actions contained in DOE categorical exclusions B5.16 "Solar photovoltaic systems" and is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
