## Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to Amicus Solar Cooperative to establish a new cooperative business entity to provide services to solar PV asset owners throughout the United States.

Activities associated with the proposed project would include establishing the corporate entity, developing the operational infrastructure, recruiting and hiring staff, developing and launching a technical training program, beginning customer and stakeholder outreach activities, and launching an on-line communication platform. The proposed standalone project is comprised exclusively of intellectual activities involving education, training, and technical assistance that do not require use of physical materials beyond basic office supplies and software.

Based on the review of the proposal, DOE has determined the proposal fits within the class of action(s) selected above. DOE has also determined that: (1) there are no extraordinary circumstances (as defined by 10 CFR 1021.410(2)) related to the proposal that may affect the significance of the environmental effects of the proposal; (2) the proposal has not been segmented to meet the definition of a categorical exclusion; and (3) the proposal is not connected to other actions with potentially significant impacts, related to other proposals with cumulatively significant actions, or an improper interim action. This proposal is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
