Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide federal funding to the City of Bellevue, WA to advance the local practice of inventorying the greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions associated with particular sources and activities within community boundaries. Findings would equip cities to understand and document the drivers of change to the inventory, whether from external factors or from changes to the efficiency of the activities within the city. It would also inform the creation of a "replication toolkit" which would clearly describe the steps in the process, and provide guidance on interpretation and visual and narrative templates for other communities to adopt and take forward.

Activities associated with the proposed project would include computer modeling, data analysis, literature review, and conference calls between team members. The proposed project would use no physical materials beyond basic office supplies and software.

Based on the review of the proposal, DOE has determined the proposal fits within the class of action(s) selected above. DOE has also determined that: (1) there are no extraordinary circumstances (as defined by 10 CFR 1021.410(2)) related to the proposal that may affect the significance of the environmental effects of the proposal; (2) the proposal has not been segmented to meet the definition of a categorical exclusion; and (3) the proposal is not connected to other actions with potentially significant impacts, related to other proposals with cumulatively significant actions, or an improper interim action. This proposal is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
