Rationale for determination:

As part of Funding Opportunity Announcement (DE-FOA-0001621) the Department of Energy (DOE) is soliciting applications from Indian Tribes (including Alaska Native Regional Corporations and Village Corporations) and Tribal Energy Resource Development Organizations to help build the knowledge, skills, and resources needed to implement energy solutions by initiating the first steps toward developing and sustaining renewable energy and energy efficiency on Tribal Lands.

For awards selected under this FOA, anticipated project activities would consist of: conducting energy options analyses; establishing baseline energy use and efficiency options; developing/establishing energy organizations; conducting climate resiliency planning; establishing policy, regulations, and codes to reduce energy use or promote energy development; and obtaining training and increasing skills, knowledge base, awareness, and expertise related to energy use and development. All anticipated project activities would consist exclusively of intellectual, academic, analytical activities and technical advice/assistance.

Based on the review of the Procurement Strategy Document, DOE has determined that all projects selected under this FOA will fit within the class of action(s) selected above. DOE has also determined that based on the types, scope, and scale of projects that could be selected under the FOA: (1) there would be no extraordinary circumstances (as defined by 10 CFR 1021.410(2)) that could affect the significance of the environmental effects of the activities; (2) the activities do not lead to segmentation to meet the definition of a categorical exclusion; and (3) the activities would have independent utility and would not be connected to other actions with potentially significant impacts, related to other proposals with cumulatively significant actions, or an improper interim action. All project selected by DOE and funded through this FOA are categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
