Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

Description:

A9 Information and dissemination

Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and gathering, analysis, audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide funding to Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians (EBCI) for the installation of an approximately 700 kilowatt (kW) sized solar photovoltaic (PV) system for generating renewable energy that would be consumed on site. The proposed site for the PV system is on EBCI reservation land adjacent to the water tower and parking lot of the Harrah's Cherokee River Casino and Hotel located in Murphy, NC. The power produced would offset the energy demand of the casino and hotel as well as two administration buildings. There are two potential sites that could be used for the PV installation. Both sites are adjacent to each other with similar topography and forest cover but the final decision on which of the two is to be used has not been made. At this time, there is not enough information to complete a thorough review of the construction and surface disturbing activities associated with the installation of the PV system at the proposed location. Once additional details of project design and siting are completed and submitted to DOE, another NEPA review will be required to assess potential impacts associated with the installation of the PV system (Tasks 1 through 4). This NEPA review is for Task 5: Reporting/Performance only. Reporting activities would consist exclusively of intellectual, academic, or analytical activities.

Based on the review of the proposal, DOE has determined that Task 5 of the proposal fits within the class of action(s) and the integral elements of Appendix B to Subpart D of 10 CFR 1021 outlined in the DOE categorical exclusion(s) selected above. DOE has also determined that: (1) there are no extraordinary circumstances (as defined by 10 CFR 1021.410(2)) related to the proposal that may affect the significance of the environmental effects of the proposal; (2) the proposal has not been segmented to meet the definition of a categorical exclusion; and (3) the proposal is not connected to other actions with potentially significant impacts, related to other proposals with cumulatively significant actions, or an improper interim action. Task 5 of the proposal is categorically excluded from further NEPA review.

DOE has made a conditional NEPA determination for this award, and funding for certain tasks under this award is contingent upon the final NEPA determination.
