Description:

DOE/EA-1968 SITEWIDE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT, U.S. DOE NATIONAL RENEWABLE ENERGY (NREL STM) LABORATORY, SOUTH TABLE MOUNTAIN CAMPUS, GOLDEN, COLORADO

Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) proposes to conduct road repair and striping activities at the National Renewable Energy Laboratory (NREL) South Table Mountain (STM) campus located in Golden, Colorado. The purpose of the proposed project is to repair portions of South Loop Road, Urban Street, and parking garage entrances and to enhance safety by refreshing pavement markings.

Surface asphalt would be removed using a rotomiller from sections of South Loop Road and Urban Street. Approximately 8,320 square feet of asphalt would be removed and recycled, and new asphalt would be laid down.

Thermoplastic pavement markings such as crosswalks, stop bars, and arrows, would be replaced at the driveway entrances to the parking garage, at the pedestrian crossings on Urban Street (northeast corner of the surface parking lot, north exit of the garage, and eastern intersection of Urban Street and South Loop Road), and at two pedestrian crossings on Denver West Parkway (south of the RSF and east of East Loop Road).

Project activities would not affect cultural resources, threatened or endangered species, wetlands, floodplains, or prime farmlands and no permits would be required. A migratory bird nesting survey would be completed if project activities occur between March 15 and September 15. If nests or eggs are found, the area would be cordoned off with a proper buffer until nestlings fledge. All ground disturbing activities would be conducted in accordance with NREL Lab Level Procedure 6-1.28: Stormwater Pollution Prevention for Construction Activities: South Table Mountain Site.

Mobile air emissions from construction equipment, such as trucks and a rotomiller, skid steer, and roller, would be negligible and short-term. Construction-related noise would consist of a short-term, intermittent increase in ambient noise levels and would follow applicable noise ordinances. Construction waste would be reused, recycled, or disposed of in accordance with applicable regulations and NREL policy and procedures.

Individuals working on this project could be exposed to physical and electrical hazards during the course of this project. Existing corporate health and safety policies and procedures would be followed including employee training. proper protective equipment, engineering controls, and monitoring. Additional policies and procedures would be implemented as necessary if new health and safety risks are identified. Traffic control measures would be used as needed.

Based on review of the project information and the above analysis, DOE has determined the proposed project would not have a significant individual or cumulative impact to human health and/or the environment. DOE has determined
