Rationale for determination:

As part of Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) DE-FOA-0001956, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) is soliciting applications that will develop new analytical tools for finding and developing geothermal resources and establish the practice of machine learning in geothermal operations. This FOA addresses the following two Topic Areas of interest:

Topic 1: Machine Learning for Geothermal Exploration

Topic 2: Advanced Analytics for Efficiency and Automation in Geothermal Operations

DOE has reviewed the descriptions of each Topic Area, and concluded that this NEPA Determination will apply only to Budget Period (BP) 1 of projects awarded under Topic 1. All projects awarded under Topic 2 will require separate NEPA review. This is because the FOA specifically limits the scope of work to be performed during BP1 of projects awarded under Topic 1 to desktop analysis of existing datasets (activities associated with this exclusive subset of DE-FOA-0001956 funding are reviewed below). Field work may be approved for BP2; therefore, these projects will require additional, separate NEPA Determinations at that time. Before advancing beyond BP1, each project funded under Topic 1 must submit individual Environmental Questionnaires (EQ-1s) detailing proposed BP2 activities.

Federal funding provided by DOE to successful applicants to Topic Area 1 would support the application of machine learning algorithms and analytics to existing geophysical, geological, and geochemical datasets. During BP1 of these awards, all projects would consist solely of intellectual, academic, and/or analytical activities, such as paper studies, data analysis, computer modeling, document preparation, data dissemination, and training. It is anticipated that BP1 activities would be conducted from existing offices or computational facilities and use no materials beyond basic office supplies, software, and computer hardware.

Any work proposed to be conducted at a DOE laboratory may be subject to additional NEPA review by the cognizant DOE NEPA Compliance Officer for the specific DOE laboratory prior to initiating such work. Further, any work conducted at a DOE laboratory must meet the laboratory's health and safety requirements.

Based on the review of the FOA document, DOE has determined that Budget Period 1 of all projects selected under

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Topic Area 1 of DE-FOA-0001956 will fit within the class of action(s) selected above. DOE has also determined that: (1) there are no extraordinary circumstances (as defined by 10 CFR 1021.410(2)) related to the proposal that may affect the significance of the environmental effects of the proposal; (2) the proposal has not been segmented to meet the definition of a categorical exclusion; and (3) the proposal is not connected to other actions with potentially significant impacts, related to other proposals with cumulatively significant actions, or an improper interim action. Budget Period 1 of all projects selected by DOE for funding under Topic Area 1 of DE-FOA-0001956 are categorically excluded from further NEPA review.

NEPA PROVISION

Any work proposed to be conducted at a DOE laboratory may be subject to additional NEPA review by the cognizant DOE NEPA Compliance Officer for the specific DOE laboratory prior to initiating such work. Further, any work conducted at a DOE laboratory must meet the laboratory's health and safety requirements.
