To: Option Term 2: Commencing in Government Fiscal Year 2020 of the, the Contract's period of performance may be extended for two additional years (July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2023) based on the standard of performance (score) and cost savings noted above.

#### 3. Option Term 3 is changed

From: Option Term 3: Commencing in the eighth year of the Contract, the Contract's period of performance may be extended for one additional year based on the standard of performance (score) and cost savings noted above.

To: Option Term 3: Commencing in Government Fiscal Year 2022 of the Contract, the Contract's period of performance may be extended for one additional year (July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024) based on the standard of performance (score) and cost savings noted above.
