The purpose of this modification is to update the contract to capture the acceleration of all site separation activities to achieve autonomous operations at Y-12 National Security Complex and Pantex Plant.

The following Clause is established under Part I – The Schedule, Section F – Deliveries or Performance:

F-9 SITE SEPARATION OF Y-12 NATIONAL SECURITY COMPLEX & PANTEX PLANT

The contractor shall accelerate all site separation activities to achieve autonomous operations at Y-12 National Security Complex and Pantex Plant without mission impact and using current resources no later than December 31, 2025, with a stretch goal of September 30, 2025. The acceleration of site separation shall be achieved through continued close coordination between the contractor and Pantex Plant M&O Contractor, PanTeXas Deterrence (PXD).

The contractor is required to deliver to the Contracting Officer no later than June 20, 2025 an addendum to the approved Site Separation Implementation Plan (SSIP), delivered in accordance with Clause F-8 DELIVERABLES DURING TRANSITION TO TWO SEPARATE M&O CONTRACTS, detailing the acceleration approach, change in execution of responsibilities by specifying those to be executed by PXD and those to be executed by the contractor, cost, and schedule changes at the site separation activity level.

Contractor agrees that it is satisfied with the sufficiency and adequacy of consideration for the contract change contemplated by this modification, including all work associated with the acceleration of site separation, and Contractor shall accomplish this work with no additional separate fee outside the Contract's Annual Control Baseline (ACB)/Annual Fee Baseline (AFB) change control process. Contractor hereby releases the Government from any and all liability under this contract for any equitable adjustments attributable to acceleration of site separation activities to achieve autonomous operations.

All other Terms and Conditions remain unchanged by this modification.
