

Request for Proposals - 89233224RNA000008 for the Management and Operation of the Savannah River Site

The Department of Energy, National Nuclear Security Administration (DOE/NNSA) has posted the solicitation for the Savannah River Site (SRS) Management and Operating (M&O) Contract Competition. The Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 89233224RNA000008 is available for public review at the SAM.gov, FedConnect, and NNSA websites.

Additionally, please note the Revolutionary FAR Overhaul has resulted in numerous updates to clauses and provisions throughout the RFP. Amendments may be issued as necessary to implement any additional DOE or Office of Procurement Policy updates.

To better promote early exchanges of information with potential Offerors, NNSA will host a facility tour prior to the proposal submission deadline.

Required Identification: Valid government issued identification; details covered in [SRS Badging Requirements](#).

Instructions: Due to tight processing times, early confirmations are encouraged. Each individual planning on attending the Facility Tour must provide the following information via email at SEB10@nnsa.doe.gov by **2:00 pm Eastern Time on Friday, March 6, 2026**:

- Name of attendee, best email, last four numbers of the attendee’s social security number, company, and confirmation of U.S. citizenship. Please indicate if the attendee has a valid DOE HSPD-12 Badge.

Safety requirements: All personnel entering the area will be required to wear construction site appropriate clothing, which consists of, at a minimum, shirts/tops with a minimum four (4) inch sleeve, and long pants or trousers. Safety shoes are preferred but, at a minimum, sturdy work shoes are required (e.g. no sandals, heels, tennis shoes). The following PPE will be provided by the SRPPF project site:
