The Northern New Mexico Citizens' Advisory Board (NNMCAB) is a federally charted committee to provide meaningful and timely advice and recommendations to the Los Alamos National Laboratory and to the Department of Energy in remediation and clean-up of materials produced by the research and development activity at the lab, primarily the so-called "legacy waste."

<u>Recommendation:</u> The NNMCAB recommends that a protocol be agreed on where by the DOE presents to the NNMCAB a bi-monthly report on the status of recommendations it has received.

The report will follow a definite format which will include:

- If the recommendation is <u>accepted</u> and the results thereof,
- If the recommendation is **not accepted**, the reason is clearly stated.
- If the recommendation is **on hold, pending** or **in suspense,** the reason is clearly stated.

<u>Benefits:</u> A timely report on the status of recommendations will be a great aid for the NNMCAB in determining its efficacy, efficiency and pertinence or relevance.
