**MOTION TO INTERVENE OF
THE WILLIAM D. SHOEMAKER JR JUNE 2007 REVOCABLE TRUST AND
THE MICHELLE M. SHOEMAKER JUNE 2007 REVOCABLE TRUST**

William and Michelle Shoemaker move to intervene as a party pursuant to Rules 212 and 214 of the Federal Regulatory Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. §§ 385.212, 385.214, as follows:

IDENTIFICATION OF MOVANTS AND AFFECTED REAL PROPERTY

1. William D. Shoemaker, Jr is the trustee of the William D. Shoemaker Jr June 2007 Revocable Trust.
2. Michelle M. Shoemaker is the trustee of the Michelle M. Shoemaker June 2007 Revocable Trust.
3. The Shoemakers reside in a home they designed and built in Pembroke, New Hampshire, known as Tax Map 260, Lot 38 and as 447 Brush Road ("Property").
4. Each of the trusts owns a half interest in the Property.

MOVANTS' INTERESTS

5. The Property is already subject to utility easement approximately 150 feet wide ("Existing Easement").
6. The originally proposed route for the Northern Pass Transmission LLC ("Northern Pass") proposal to construct, operate, maintain, and connect an electric transmission

line ("Project") includes both: the Existing Easement; and an additional 45-foot wide easement also across the Property that has yet to be acquired by Northern Pass (or related entities).

7. Upon information and belief, the route proposed in the amended application Northern Pass filed on July 1, 2013 includes the same route as it pertains to the Property.

8. The Shoemakers will be directly impacted should the Project be permitted, including if the Project is issued the requested Presidential Permit, because of its location right across the Property, among other possible impacts.

9. As a result of the direct impact upon their Property, the Shoemakers are concerned about the Project.

10. They also may be directly affected by the outcome should their rates of using or receiving electricity increase and their participation in this docket as intervenors would serve the public interest.

11. No other party can adequately represent the Shoemakers' interests in this proceeding.
