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MISSION AND BUSINESS MODEL

DOE's mission is to ensure America's security and prosperity by addressing its energy, environmental and nuclear challenges through transformative science and technology solutions. OSBP advances DOE's mission by expanding small business participation in Agency programs and initiatives.

DOE's unique Management and Operating business model means that the Agency's facilities are owned by the government and managed by large prime contractors. Approximately 80% of DOE's small business spend is subcontracted dollars.



MENTOR-PROTÉGÉ PROGRAM

DOE's Mentor-Protégé Program (MPP) develops long-term partnerships between small businesses and Agency prime contractors. The program helps increase DOE prime contracts and subcontracts to expand the American energy small business industrial base.
