The National Nuclear Security Administration's Uranium Processing Facility Site Infrastructure and Services Subproject

The Uranium Processing Facility (UPF) Site Infrastructure and Services subproject team is commended for delivering the second UPF subproject \$18M under budget and on schedule. Successful completion of the UPF Site Infrastructure and Services subproject represents progress towards achieving NNSA's commitment to complete the UPF Project and cease enriched uranium programmatic operations in Building 9212 by the end of 2025 for a cost not to exceed \$6.5 billion. The project team used management and operating contractor, Consolidated Nuclear Security, LLC, and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) for a combination of fixed unit rate and cost-plus contracts. This allowed NNSA to reduce project costs and risks, advance the Department's policy to align contract incentives with taxpayer interests, and leverage core USACE strengths including their experience with infrastructure construction and the use of firm fixed-price construction contracts.
