To the Office of Oil and Gas Global Security and Supply:

On January 17, 2012, in Order No. 3059, the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy (“DOE/OFE”), granted to Cameron LNG, LLC (“Cameron LNG”) a long-term, multi-contract authorization to export liquefied natural gas (“LNG”) to Free Trade Agreement nations. Subsequently, on February 11, 2014, in Order No. 3391, DOE/OFE granted to Cameron LNG a conditional authorization to export LNG to non-Free Trade Agreement nations. One of the conditions of each of those authorizations is that Cameron LNG file semi-annual written reports (on or before April 1 and October 1 of each year) describing the progress of the planned liquefaction facility from which Cameron LNG will export LNG. Cameron LNG hereby submits such semi-annual report for the six-month period ending **March 31, 2014.**

On December 7, 2012, Cameron LNG filed an application with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“FERC”) pursuant to Section 3 of the Natural Gas Act for authorization to construct and operate the facilities necessary to export LNG. That application is currently pending before FERC. In addition, Cameron LNG is currently engaged in project development activities. During the six-month period ending on March 31, 2014, Cameron LNG executed an engineering, procurement and construction contract for the project, and obtained commitments from lenders for project financing. Based on the anticipated timing of receipt of necessary authorizations and the project construction schedule, Cameron LNG expects to achieve commercial operation of all three of its liquefaction trains in 2018, and have the first full year of production of LNG in 2019. previously reported, Cameron LNG has executed long-term contracts with project customers for export of LNG from the project.
