Electricity in Jordan



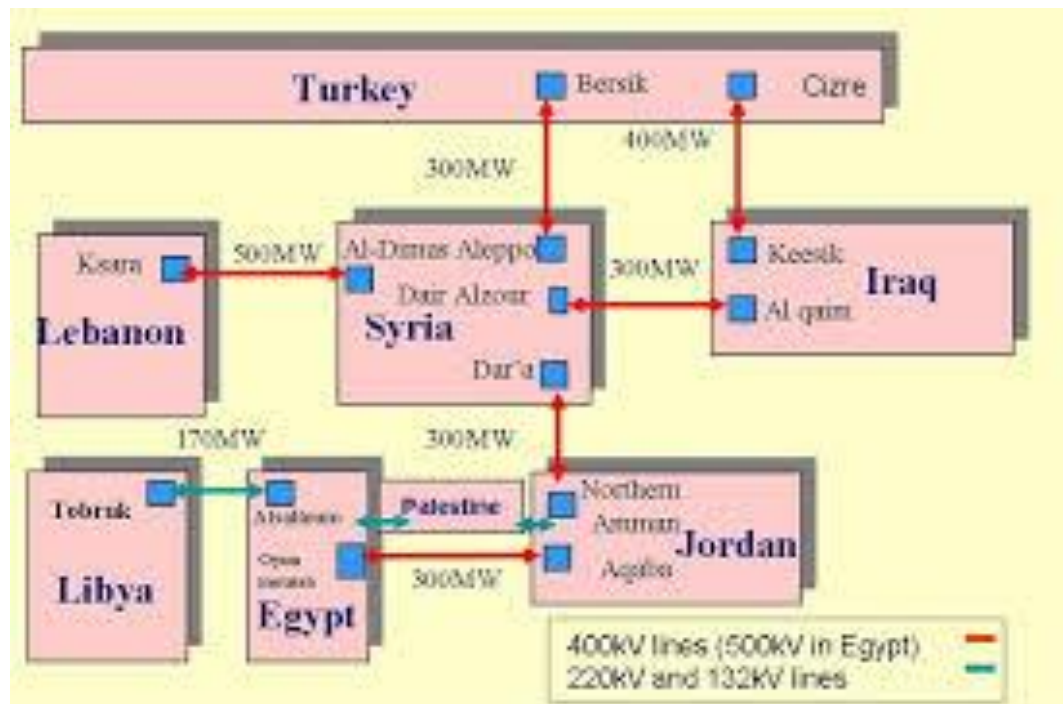
- 96% of oil & natural gas is imported.
