When completed, the HE S&E would serve as the scientific and engineering hub supporting all High Explosive Center of Excellence activities and technology development activities at the Pantex Plant.

The public is invited to review and comment on a draft Environmental Assessment that has been prepared to analyze potential environmental consequences of the proposed project.
