**NOTICE**

Issued: July 31, 2015

**This Notice amends the Notice of Noncompliance Determination issued in this case on June 11, 2015.**

On June 11, 2015, the Department of Energy (“DOE”) issued a Notice of Noncompliance Determination (“Noncompliance Determination”) to Grandlite International Corporation (“Grandlite”) finding that 228 metal halide lamp fixture models do not comply with the applicable federal energy conservation standard.

The Noncompliance Determination stated that Grandlite manufactured models IL417H40M-U, SM019H40M-U, SM707H25M-U BNZ, SM708H40M BNZ, and SM708H40M-U BNZ. Based on information provided by Grandlite, Grandlite does not import or otherwise manufacture these five models. Based upon this information, DOE **WITHDRAWS** its finding that Grandlite manufactured units of metal halide models IL417H40M-U, SM019H40M-U, SM707H25M-U BNZ, SM708H40M BNZ, and SM708H40M-U BNZ. This does not affect DOE’s determination that these models do not comply with the applicable federal energy conservation standard.

The Notice of Noncompliance Determination issued June 11, 2015, **REMAINS EFFECTIVE** for the remaining 223 metal halide lamp fixture models.

Grandlite is not required to take any additional action as a result of this Notice.
