Pursuant to Condition J of DOE/FE Order 3968 ("Order"), Driftwood LNG LLC ("DWLNG") is providing herein the semi-annual status report for the Driftwood LNG Facility.

On March 31, 2017, Driftwood LNG LLC and Driftwood Pipeline LLC (together, "Driftwood") filed an application with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") in Docket Nos. CP17-117-000 and CP17-118-000 requesting authorization to site, construct and operate the proposed Driftwood LNG production and export facility ("LNG Facility") and the proposed Driftwood Pipeline, an associated 96-mile-long interstate natural gas pipeline ("Application"). In the Application Driftwood asked that FERC issue an order granting the requested authorizations by no later than March 30, 2018 so that DWLNG may begin construction of the LNG Facility by the second quarter of 2018 and send its first cargo out by the third quarter of 2022.

DWLNG is in the midst of developing and negotiating commercial agreements associated with the LNG Facility, and will submit those long-term agreements required pursuant to Condition D(1) and D(2) of the Order following execution.
