

Energy Materials Network (EMN): 4 Pillars

- 1. Create and manage a resource network of world class materials capabilities within the DOE national laboratories
- 2. Provide single point-of-contact concierge for industry to materials R&D network
- 3. Capture and share data by creating repositories and distribution routes for non-proprietary data
- 4. Streamline access to network through standard NDAs, CRADAs, etc.




Streamlined Access & Agreements




- Develop a suite of pre-negotiated technology transfer agreements specifically designed for the ElectroCat Consortium.
- Facilitate rapid, uniform agreement execution amongst participating laboratories, as well as, between the ElectroCat Consortium and industrial partners.
