UESC Contract Standardization and Outreach

- Utility Partnership Program Website – Ongoing Updates
 - Welcome new utilities offering UESCs: Dominion: Dominion East Ohio, Dominion Hope, Dominion Questar
 - Help FEMP stay up-to-date
 - New staff? Update Utility Points of Contact with FEMP
 - UESC Maps are online and in your registration handout; any changes?
- Continuing work on Feasibility Study Format Standardization
 - Development stage
 - Draft expected in May

Data Collection and Reporting

- UESC Data
 - More than \$3 billion in investments since 1995
 - Almost 2000 UESC projects
 - Over \$57 million in new projects reported by utilities in FY 2017
- Updating UESC Data Reporting Process
 - New guidance in registration booklet
 - Streamlining UESC reporting
 - Collecting UESC data in same template as the Compliance Tracking System (CTS)
 - CTS and Utility Program data reports should now be consistent
- Importance of Submitting Data to FEMP
 - Increasing participation in data reporting is critical to the success of the program
 - The more accurately the data reflects the UESC market, the better FEMP can understand current trends and successes and continue to grow the program
