To Whom it May Concern:

Pursuant to Condition J of DOE/FE Order 3968 ("Order"), Driftwood LNG LLC ("DWLNG") is providing herein the semi-annual status report for the Driftwood LNG Facility.

On March 31, 2017, Driftwood LNG LLC and Driftwood Pipeline LLC (together, "Driftwood") filed an application with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") under Docket Nos. CP17-117-000 and CP17-118-000 requesting authorization for the liquefied natural gas production and export facility and a 96-mile natural gas pipeline (together, "Project"). Driftwood requested that the FERC issue an order granting the authorizations by no later than March 30, 2018 so that DWLNG may begin construction of the Project by the second quarter of 2018 and send its first cargo out by the third quarter of 2022.

DWLNG is continuing to develop and negotiate terms for long-term LNG export contracts and long-term supply contracts for the Driftwood LNG Facility. In accordance with Condition D(1) and D(2) of the Order, DWLNG will file a copy of long-term contracts upon execution.
