

### **Navajo Tribal Utility Authority**



Primary Multi-utility provider on the Navajo Nation

Electricity, Water, Natural Gas, Wastewater Treatment, Renewable Energy, and Communications

- Created in 1959
- A non-profit enterprise of the Navajo Nation
- Today NTUA continues to address the multi-utility needs of the Navajo Nation
- Service Territory 27,000 square miles across the Navajo Nation
- Seven District Offices serve as a central point for business operations
- Extends Electricity, Water,
   Wastewater Treatment, Natural
   Gas, Renewable Energy
- In recent years added: Communications – Internet, Cell Phone, and Data Storage Services




### **Navajo Nation – Southwest USA**

- 186,500 Citizens
- Territory larger than West Virginia
- Unemployment rate of 48.5% - (9 times current U.S. average)
- 38% of Navajo people live below poverty line
- Avg per capita income of \$10,695 vs U.S. avg of \$48,377
