Sovereign Power Vertical Integration










Sovereign Solar

 - Quality Control
 - Operations and Maintenance
- Sales Force Development (1 position)




Sovereign Biomass Business Unit

 - Federal (BIA)


Sovereign Biomass

- Opportunities
 - Skilled Labor Development
 - Monthly Utility Burden Mitigation
 - Works very well with Solar PV and Solar Hot Water
- Micro-Grid Heat Energy Generation
 - Ability to island power and separate from grid
 - Energy resiliency



Sovereign Power Distribution

- Skilled Labor Development

 - Example: Yakama Power will have 4 line crews with between 80-90 employees (All tribal skilled labor) serving the region as the largest utility service business in the region.
- Back Office Development (minimum 1 position)
 - Monthly account payments structure to Sovereign
 Power
- System Monitoring (minimum 1 position)


Sovereign Power Distribution
