Formal Public Interaction

- **April 9: INL Citizens Advisory Board Meeting:** Idaho Falls, Idaho
- **April 30: Congressional Nuclear Cleanup Caucus Briefing:** U.S. Department of Energy, Idaho Cleanup Project Deputy Manager Jim Cooper, CH2M-WG Idaho President and CEO Tom Dieter, and Idaho Treatment Group President and Project Manager Danny Nichols discussed cleanup accomplishments and upcoming challenges at the 2014 Nuclear Cleanup Caucus in Washington, D.C.
- **June 3: Public Comment Period Opens:** The public comment opened for the permit modification request (PMR) for the Secondary Sodium System tank system storage unit associated with demolition activities at Experimental Breeder Reactor-II. The public comment period closes on August 1, 2014.
- **June 11: Public Meeting:** The U.S. Department of Energy and environmental cleanup contractor CH2M-WG Idaho held a public meeting in Idaho Falls to discuss the permit modification request for the sodium distillation project at Idaho Nuclear Technology and Engineering Center.
- **June 23: U.S. Department of Energy News Release:** The Department of Energy issued a news release naming the newly appointed INL Citizen's Advisory Board members.
- **June 25: Public Meeting:** The U.S. Department of Energy and environmental cleanup contractor CH2M-WG Idaho held a public meeting in Idaho Falls to discuss the permit modification request (PMR) for the Secondary Sodium System tank system storage unit associated with demolition activities at Experimental Breeder Reactor-II.
- **July 1: Idaho Cleanup Project News Release:** CH2M-WG, Idaho, LLC issued a news release announcing that they had, recently completed a technically challenging sodium-treatment project seven weeks ahead of schedule at the Experimental Breeder Reactor-II.
