To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to Condition J of DOE/FE Order 3968 ("Order"), Driftwood LNG LLC ("DWLNG") is providing herein the semi-annual status report for the Driftwood LNG Facility for the period October 1, 2017, through March 31, 2018.

On March 31, 2017, Driftwood LNG LLC and Driftwood Pipeline LLC (together, "Driftwood") filed an application with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") under Docket Nos. CP17-117-000 and CP17-118-000 requesting authorization for the liquefied natural gas production and export facility and a 96-mile natural gas pipeline (together, "Project"). On December 22, 2017, FERC issued the Notice of Schedule for Environmental Review of the Project. On February 15, 2018, DWLNG filed with FERC to clarify and update the terminal's optimized estimated LNG production capacity and made a parallel filing with DOE/FE on March 5, 2018. Driftwood expects the first LNG export in 2023.

DWLNG is continuing to develop and negotiate terms for long-term LNG export contracts and long-term supply contracts for the Driftwood LNG Facility. In accordance with Condition D(1) and D(2) of the Order, DWLNG will file a copy of long-term contracts upon execution.
