
Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph O of DOE/FE Order No. 4078,¹ Eagle LNG Partners Jacksonville II LLC (“Eagle Maxville”) hereby submits its semi-annual report describing the progress of the liquefaction facility.

As of April 1, 2018, the Maxville liquefaction facility is complete and operational. The liquefaction facility began filling the onsite tank with produced LNG in February 2018. Currently, Eagle Maxville has not executed any export contracts, although it is continuing to progress commercial discussions with potential off-takers. At this time, Eagle Maxville does not have an expected date for when it will commence first exports of LNG.
