On March 22, 2018, the New Mexico Environment Department's Hazardous Waste Bureau approved a Class 1 Permit Modification Request for Newport News Nuclear BWXT – Los Alamos, LLC (N3B) (a Permittee) to become a co-operator of the Los Alamos National Laboratory Hazardous Waste Permit.
