ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO AMEND AUTHORIZATION TO
EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO CANADA TO
REFLECT CORPORATE NAME CHANGE

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 4274-A

On September 26, 2018, the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) issued DOE/FE Order No. 4274 (FE Docket No. 18-130-NG), under section 3 of the Natural Gas Act (NGA).¹ That order granted the entity then-known as Union Gas Limited (Union Gas) authorization to export up to 53.35 billion cubic feet per year (Bcf/y) of natural gas to Canada, for a term of 15 years that began on October 1, 2018, and extends through September 30, 2033.

On December 19, 2018, DOE/FE was notified that Union Gas and Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. amalgamated into a single entity, effective January 1, 2019.² As a result, Union

Gas' corporate name has been changed to "Enbridge Gas Inc." (Enbridge Gas), effective January 1, 2019.

Finding good cause, DOE/FE hereby grants Enbridge Gas' request to amend the specified authorization to reflect its corporate name change. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, it is hereby ordered that DOE/FE Order No. 4274 is amended to substitute Enbridge Gas Inc. as the exporter of natural gas, effective January 1, 2019. All obligations arising under the order apply to Enbridge Gas, and all other terms and conditions of the order shall remain in full force and effect.
