

#### **MISSION**


U.S. Department of Energy's Office of Fossil

Micro-purchase threshold increased to \$10K

Site operations support prime contracts

#### **Contract Vehicles**

-Most common use of existing Sole Source 8a firms – cost reimbursable and firm fixed price
