2. PROJECT DESCRIPTION: NIF would conduct High Energy Density Science (HEDS) program objectives			
by introducing a target with the high explosive triaminotrinitrobenzene (TATB). TATB is a non-primary			
initiating explosive that is extremely insensitive to shock, vibration, fire, or impact. The goal of the			
experiments is to shock TATB and measure the reaction products. No single target (or single			
experiment) will involve more than 10 mg of TATB. The TARget, Diffraction, In-Situ (TARDIS) platform			
would be used in conjunction with the TATB. TARDIS is commonly used at NIF to evaluate states of			
material at very high pressures.
