Strengthen the nonproliferation and arms control regimes to prevent proliferation, ensure peaceful nuclear uses, and enable verifiable nuclear reductions.

CHALLENGES:

- Build capacity of the IAEA and partner countries to implement international safeguards obligations (*Office of International Nuclear Safeguards*)
- Build domestic and international capacity to implement export control obligations (*Office of Nuclear Export Controls*)
- Support negotiation of and implement agreements and associated monitoring regimes to verifiably reduce nuclear weapons and nuclear programs (*Office of Nuclear Verification*)
- Develop programs and strategies to address emerging nonproliferation and arms control challenges and opportunities (*Office of Nonproliferation Policy*)
