Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph J of DOE/FE Order No. 3867¹, and Ordering Paragraph M of DOE/FE Order No. 4445², Eagle LNG Partners Jacksonville LLC ("Eagle LNG") submits its semi-annual report providing the progress on the proposed liquefaction facility.

Eagle LNG has been authorized by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission to site and construct its proposed liquefaction facility³ but the facility has not yet commenced construction. Eagle LNG is continuing to progress commercial discussions with potential off-takers.
