Anthony,

Thank you for your email about Advanced Energy Solutions, LLC (AES). We appreciate your questions about the possible changes to AES's existing order to export LNG to free trade agreement (FTA) countries, DOE/FE Order No. 3360.

In light of the extent of amendments that may be necessary, we likely would advise AES to vacate its existing order (without prejudice), and have AES submit a new application for a FTA order once AES secures a new LNG loading facility. DOE is required to grant FTA applications "without modification or delay" under section 3(c) of the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C. § 717b(c)), so we could process the new application promptly. That would also reset the clock for the authorization, based on the length of the export term requested by AES. AES could consolidate these requests in one filing, or submit separate documents.

We are happy to discuss these steps with you, if you think that would be helpful. If so, is there a day or time next week that works for you?

Jennifer,

Regarding the LNG export license granted in 2013 to Advanced Energy Solution, LLC (AES) here are a few questions for the US Department of Energy (DOE) which would help to determine the utility and/or value of the LNG export license going forward.

Given that the Floridian Natural Gas Storage Facility, which was approved by FERC but never built, is no longer a viable option for loading LNG into approved ISO containers as specified in the license "Order" section, can the following items be amended in the exiting license should a new LNG loading facility be secured:

1. **Supply source of gas to be liquified and exported (this is not in the "Order" section, but discussed in the body of the license)**
2. **Location and operator of loading facility (currently Floridian LNG production facility, which was permitted by FERC but never built)**
3. **Location of export port (currently Port of Palm Beach, FL)**

4. Annual export volumes (currently 8 Bcf/yr)
