Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph O of DOE/FE Order No. 4078,¹ Eagle LNG Partners Jacksonville II LLC (“Eagle Maxville”) submits its semi-annual report providing an update in respect of the development status of and export-related activities associated with the Eagle Maxville liquefaction facility.

The Eagle Maxville liquefaction facility is currently operational and has executed export contracts since its prior semi-annual report, as noted below:

- 1) An agreement between Eagle Maxville and Tiger Law Marketing LLC, which was executed in August 2021, and was filed under separate cover with the DOE on September 3, 2021.

Eagle Maxville commenced first exports of LNG via ISO container in August 2021, and has submitted, and will continue to submit, monthly reports to the DOE summarizing those exports. Eagle Maxville will continue to update the DOE as other export agreements progress or as additional LNG volumes are exported.
