Emera CNG, LLC ("Emera") was previously granted long-term authorizations under Section 3 of the Natural Gas Act to export compressed natural gas to both free trade agreement ("FTA") and non-FTA countries.

More particularly: (1) on June 13, 2014, Emera was granted authorization to export 9.125 billion cubic feet per year ("Bcf/yr") of compressed natural gas to FTA countries in DOE/FE Order No. 3447; and (2) on October 19, 2015, Emera was granted authorization to export 2.92 Bcf/yr of compressed natural gas to non-FTA countries in DOE/FE Order No. 3727 (collectively, the "Authorizations").

Because the facility for which the Authorizations were obtained never entered operation, Emera respectfully requests that DOE/FE Order Nos. 3447 and 3727 be vacated effective immediately.
