Dear Ms. Wood:

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph H of DOE/FE Order No. 3412, *Jordan Cove LNG L.P.* (“JCLNG”) hereby submits its semi-annual report describing the status of its long-term contracts for the import or supply of natural gas.¹ On January 19, 2021, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission issued an order denying the petition for declaratory order of *Jordan Cove Energy Project L.P.* and *Pacific Connector Gas Pipeline, LP*, determining that Oregon had not waived its Clean Water Act Section 401 certification authority with respect to the *Jordan Cove LNG* export facility.² Subsequently, on February 8, 2021, the Department of Commerce sustained Oregon’s objection under the Coastal Zone Management Act.³ JCLNG has decided to pause negotiations regarding long-term imports and supplies of natural gas while it assesses the impact of these permitting decisions.
