Semi-Annual Report

Dear Ms. Wood:

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph H of DOE/FE Order No. 3412, Jordan Cove LNG L.P. ("JCLNG") hereby submits its semi-annual report describing the status of its long-term contracts for the import or supply of natural gas.¹ On January 19, 2021, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission issued an order denying the petition for declaratory order of Jordan Cove Energy Project L.P. and Pacific Connector Gas Pipeline, LP, determining that Oregon had not waived its Clean Water Act Section 401 certification authority with respect to the Jordan Cove LNG export facility.² Subsequently, on February 8, 2021, the Department of Commerce sustained Oregon's objection under the Coastal Zone Management Act.³ JCLNG has decided to pause negotiations regarding long-term imports and supplies of natural gas while it assesses the impact of these permitting decisions.
