Summary of Meeting:

- ACEEE thanked DOE for issuing the SNOPR
- DOE confirmed that an item under the docket listed at Office of Management and Budget's regulatory dashboard would be made available for public comment
- ACEEE said they are working on analysis on affordability that might be issued after the end of the comment period as well as related comments.
- DOE indicated that indoor air quality would be addressed in more detail in the environmental impact statement.
- ACEEE expressed concern that the proposed Tier 1 would not help low-income residents, that
 there may be cheaper savings not included in the draft standard, and that some costs may be
 overestimated in the analysis
