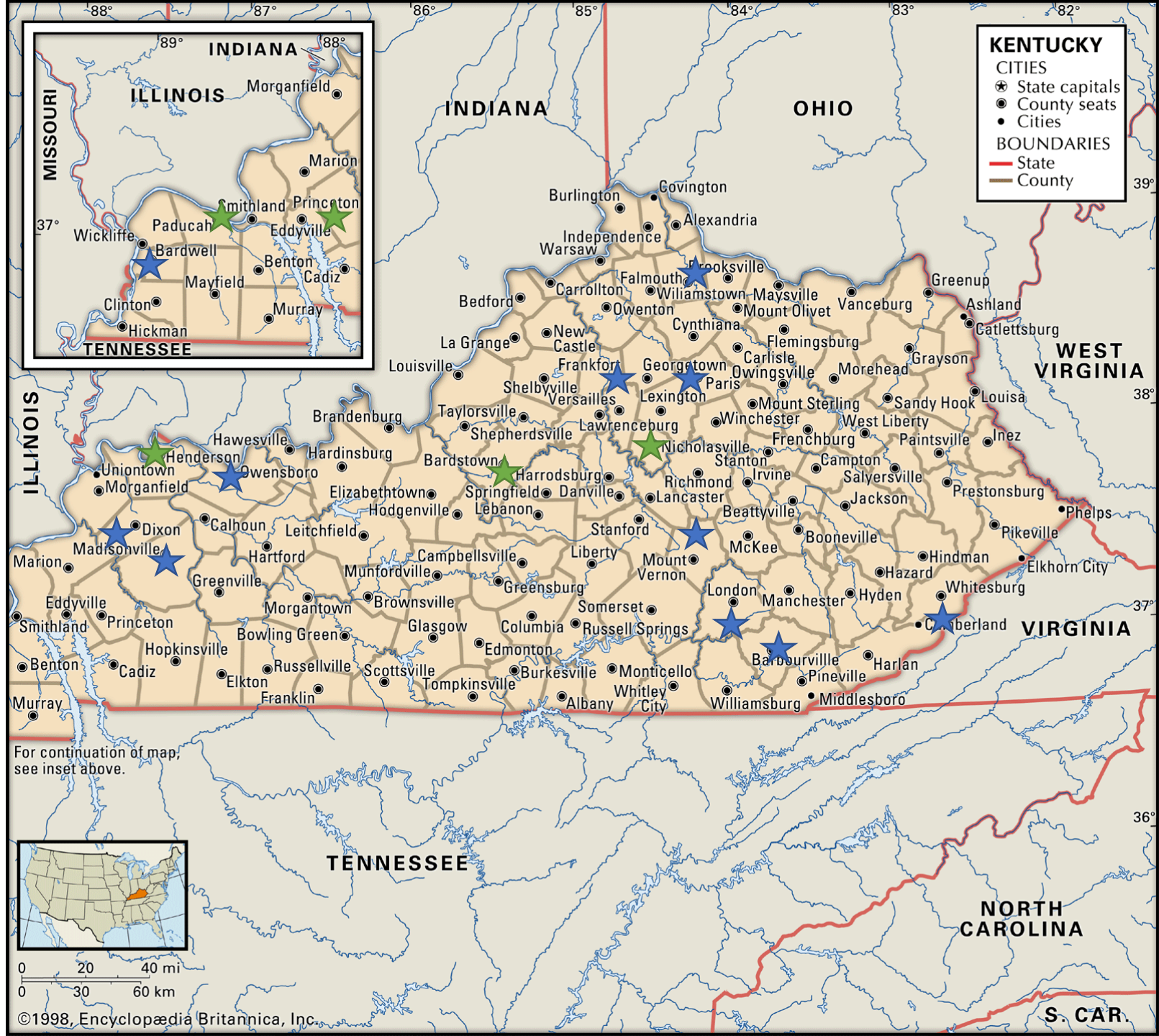

Frankfort, KY

- Capitol city of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
- Formally a county of the Commonwealth of Virginia
- Unlike several KY city's namesake (Paris, Versailles), Frankfort has no relationship to Frankfurt
- Home to Buffalo Trace Distillery (1792) – brands include Col. E. H. Taylor, Eagle Rare, Old Charter, W. L. Weller, Wheatley, Blanton's, and Pappy Van Winkle
- Site of Daniel and Rebecca Boone's grave

Home of the Famous KFC Recipe – first restaurant opened in 1930

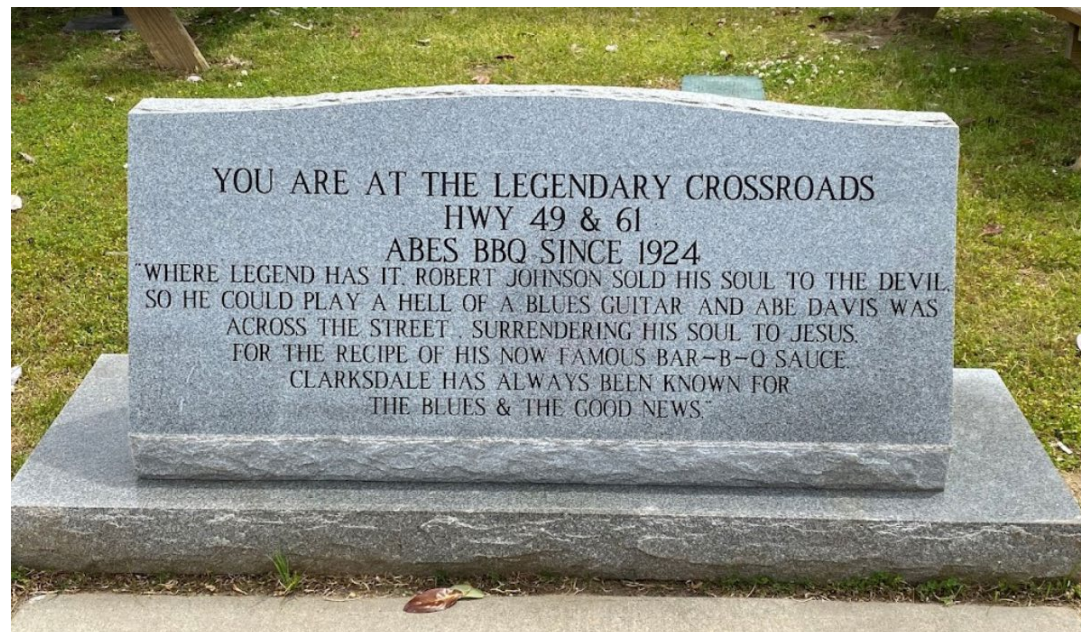
