Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Policy 451.1), I have made the following determination:

Description:

A9 Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination

Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. Small-scale renewable energy research and development projects and small-scale pilot projects, provided that the projects are located within a previously disturbed or developed area. Covered actions would be in accordance with applicable requirements (such as local land use and zoning requirements) in the proposed project area and would incorporate appropriate control technologies and best management practices.

Rationale for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy is proposing to provide funding to AccuSolar in support of a project intended to finalize and validate a new design concept for floating solar photovoltaic (PV) systems in an effort to reduce costs during manufacturing as well as installation and anchoring. The project would be completed over three Budget Periods (BPs). During BP1 the project would focus on system and component design exploration and finalization, modeling and analysis of fabrication, installation, and operational costs and value and identifying test sites for deployment and validation in BP2 and BP3. BP2 would include fabrication, installation and commissioning of test sites and validation and improvements of cost models and system design. BP3 would focus on monitoring and data collection as well as development of a manufacturing plan and supply chain definition.

Sufficient information in not currently available to conduct a meaningful NEPA review of BP2 and BP3 activities. This NEPA Determination is applicable to BP1 only. Additional BOE NEPA review is required and must be complete prior to initiating BP2 and/or BP3 activities.

BP1 activities would include system design, engineering analysis, techno-economic analysis, fabrication of a subscale system prototype, stakeholder engagement, and test site investigation. Activities would be conducted at existing facilities in Pompano Beach, Florida. No field work or site preparation would occur during BP1. DOE does not anticipate any impacts to resources of concern as a result of BP1 activities.
