PROPOSED DEMOLITION OF THE BUILDINGS AT THE PIQUA, OHIO, DECOMMISSIONED REACTOR SITE

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Office of Legacy Management (LM) has issued a final Environmental Assessment (EA) (DOE/EA-2107) and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) to demolish the buildings and maintain protectiveness of the entombed low-level radiological waste materials at the Piqua, Ohio, Decommissioned Reactor Site in Miami County. A 30-day public comment period for the draft EA concluded on September 19, 2021.
