DOE/FECM ORDER NO. 4779

On December 22, 2021, the Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management (FECM) of the Department of Energy (DOE) issued DOE/FECM Order No. 4779 to New World Global, LLC (New World Global) under section 3(c) of the Natural Gas Act, 15 U.S.C. § 717b(c). Ordering Paragraph A, at page 3 of the above-referenced Order, is hereby corrected to read as follows:

- A. New World Global is authorized for the activity described in the list below. This authorization shall be effective for a two-year term beginning on January 14, 2022, and extending through January 13, 2024.
 - 1. Import liquefied natural gas (LNG) from Canada by truck at any LNG receiving facility in the United States and its territories
 - 2. Export LNG to Mexico by truck from any LNG departure facility in the United States and its territories.

The applicant is authorized to import and export up to a combined total volume equivalent to 24 Bcf of natural gas.

Additionally, Ordering Paragraph C, at page 4 of the above-referenced Order, is hereby corrected to read as follows:

C. The first monthly report required by this Order is due not later than February 28, 2022, and should cover the reporting period from January 14, 2022 through January 31, 2022.

All other Findings and Ordering Paragraphs in DOE/FECM Order No. 4779 remain in full force and effect.
