ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FECM ORDER NO. 4613-A

MARCH 7, 2022

On October 22, 2020, in DOE/FE Order No. 4613, the Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management (FECM)¹ of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to ARC Resources U.S. Energy Marketing Ltd. (ARC Resources U.S. Energy Marketing) to import 100 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas from Canada by pipeline. This blanket authorization extends for a two-year term beginning on October 22, 2020, and extending through October 21, 2022.

On January 21, 2022, ARC Resources U.S. Energy Marketing notified DOE that this authorization is no longer needed. ARC Resources U.S. Energy Marketing therefore requests that DOE vacate Order No. 4613, effective February 1, 2022.² DOE finds good cause to do so.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, ARC Resources U.S. Energy Marketing's blanket authorization to import 100 Bcf of natural gas from Canada, granted in DOE/FE Order No. 4613 on October 22, 2020, is hereby vacated, effective February 1, 2022. Issued in Washington, D.C., on March 7, 2022.
